I hope that you are keeping well during this busy season of Advent. As we look ahead to 2019, there are a few key dates to note in your calendars for the grant program. I invite you to please share these dates with your presbytery.

The [Rural and Remote Ministry Grant](#) is separated into two streams:

- Student Grants – Applications must be received by **February 15, 2019** in order to be considered
- Leadership Grants – Leadership grant applications can be submitted at any time (please contact the Canadian Ministries office to apply)

Also of note, applications for the following grants must be received by **April 15, 2019**:

- Avondbloem Experimental Fund
- Chisholm Fund
- McBain-Barker Small Community Capital Fund
- Special Projects Fund

If there are funds remaining after the April review, additional applications will be considered if received by October 15, 2019.

The Presbyterian Church in Canada offers funding to help in a variety of other areas including children and youth ministry, worship, lay training, conferences, mission work, and more. A detailed listing of all the grants can be found online at <http://presbyterian.ca/canadian-ministries/funds>.
